



Egyptian Gods

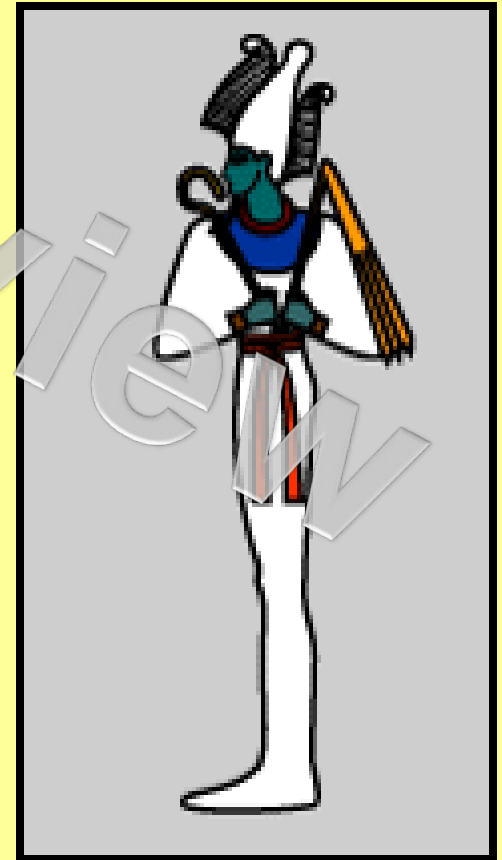




Osiris

Osiris was the god of the dead, and ruler of the underworld.

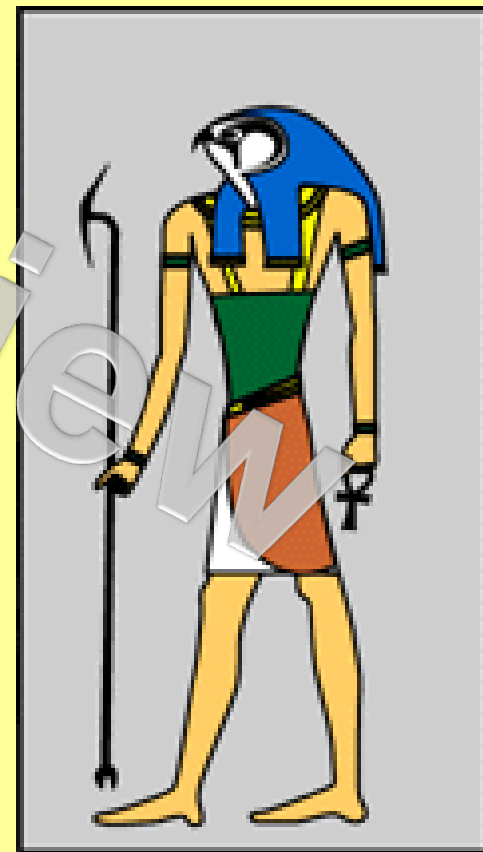




Horus

Horus was a man with the head of a hawk. He was a god of the sky. He is probably most well-known as the protector of the ruler of Egypt.

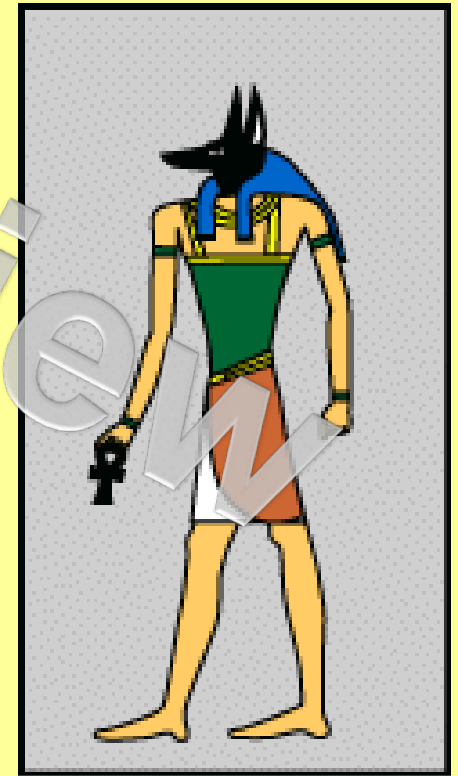
The Egyptians believed that the pharaoh was the 'living Horus'.

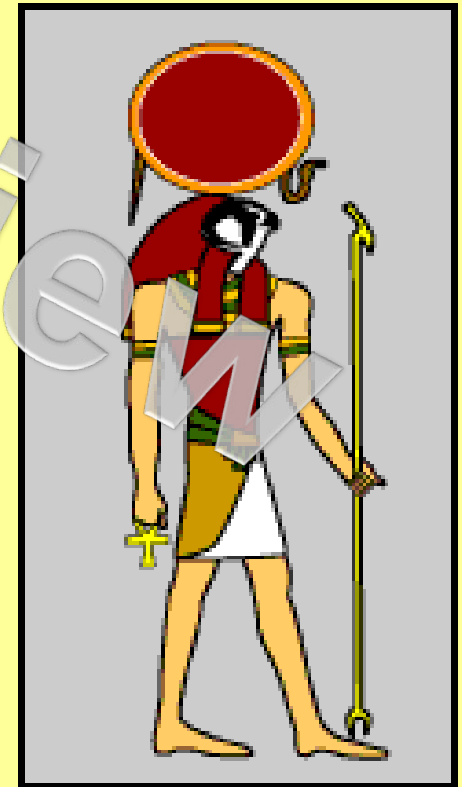




Ra

Ra was a man with hawk head and headdress with a sun disk. Ra was the sun god. He was the most important god of the ancient Egyptians.

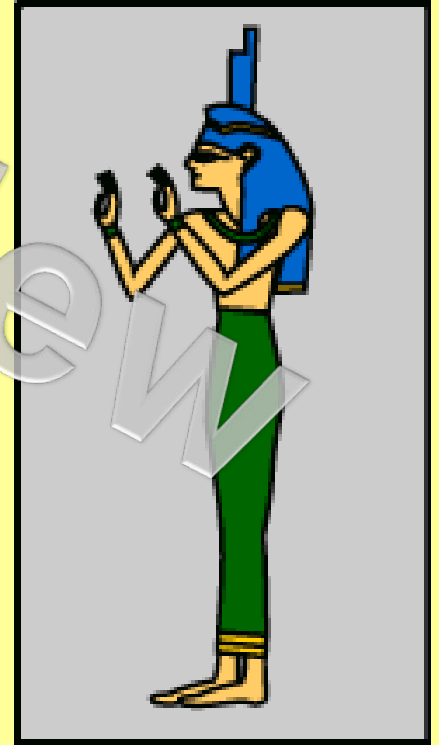
The ancient Egyptians believed that Ra was swallowed every night by the sky goddess Nut, and was reborn every morning.

Isis was a woman with headdress in the shape of a throne and a pair of cow horns with a sun disk. Isis was a protective goddess. She used powerful magic spells to help people in need. Isis was the wife of Osiris and the mother of Horus.





Hathor

Hathor was a woman with the ears of a cow, a headdress of horns and a sun disk. Hathor was a protective goddess. She was also the goddess of love and joy. Hathor was the wife of Horus, and was sometimes thought of as the mother of the pharaoh.
