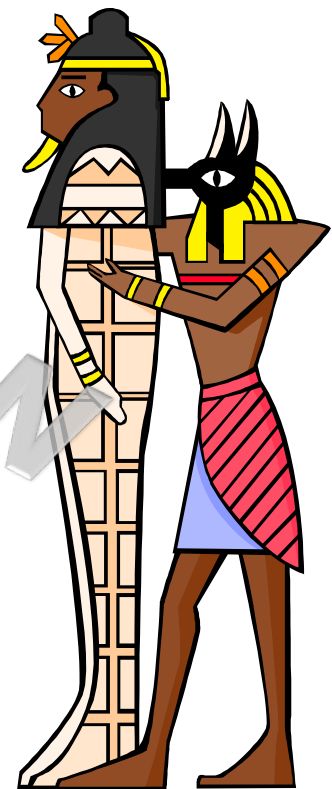
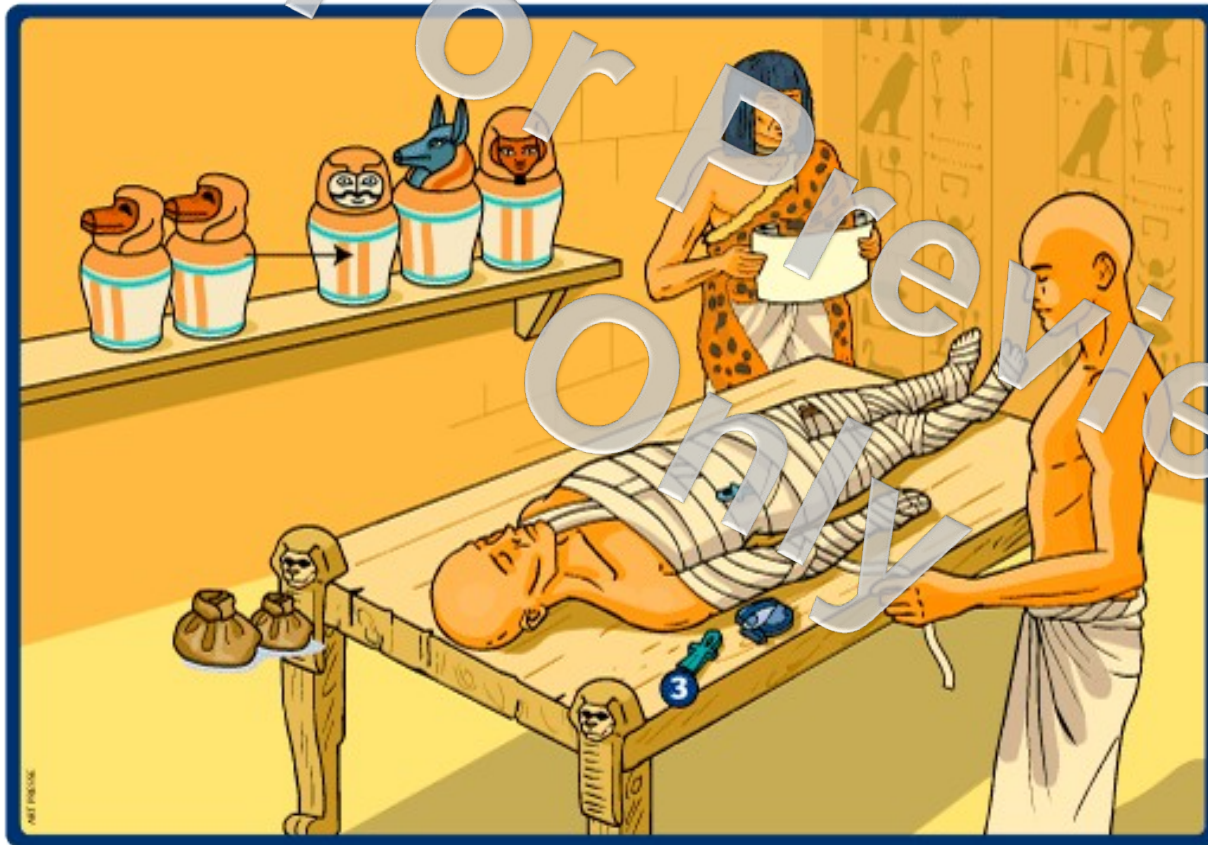


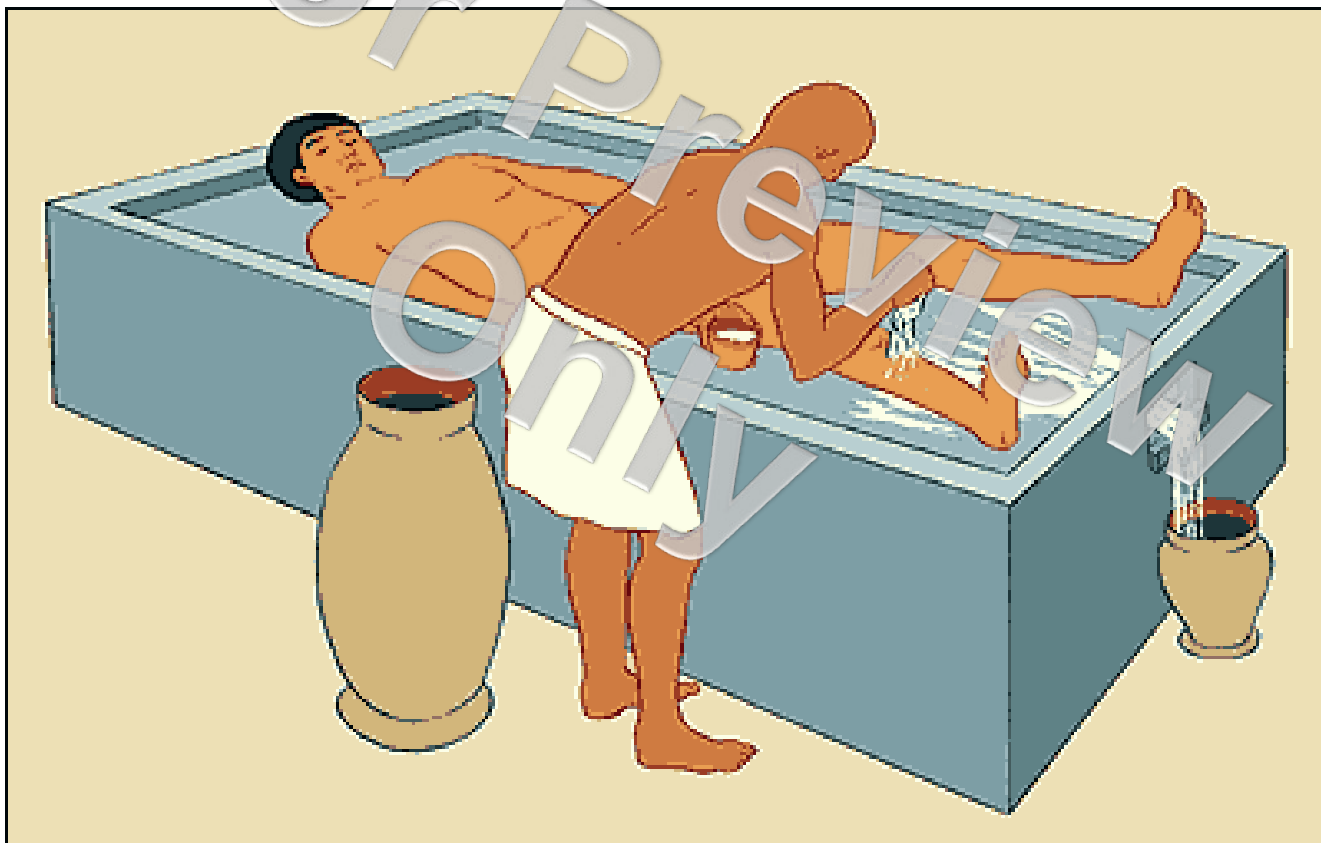


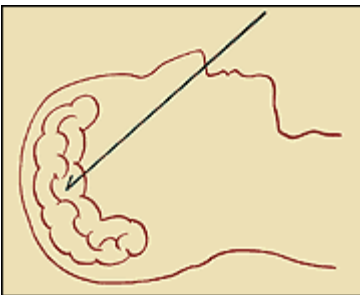
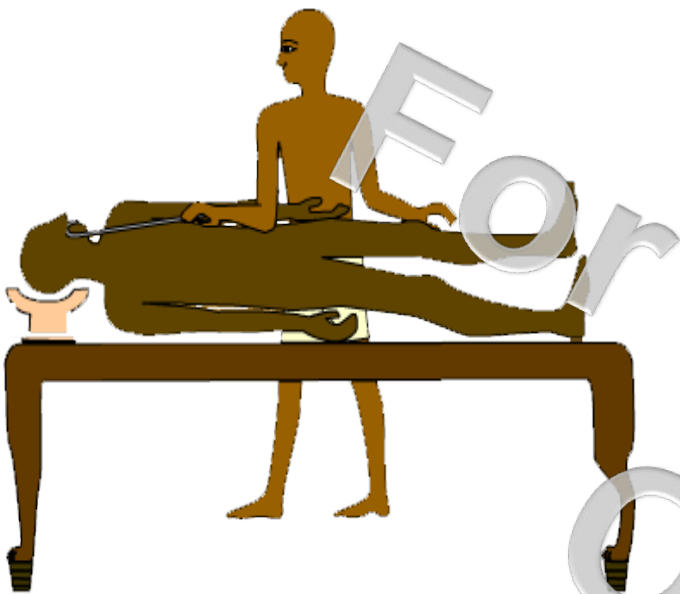
How to Make a Mummy





First of all, wash the body in the river Nile.
Shave off any excess hair.





Secondly, remove the body's brain using a hook. Push the hook through the roof of the nose towards the brain. Move the hook backwards to forwards to mash up the brain. Turn the body over, so the brain comes out of the nostrils.

Next remove the vital organs. These have to be preserved in canopic jars. However you must leave the heart in the body. The heart will be needed in the afterlife.





The next step is cover the body in natron salt for 40 days. This will help to preserve it. After this time, the body will appear darker.



After the natron salt has been used, stuff the body's cavities with resin soaked linen.



Next we must make the body look good for the afterlife. Apply make up to the face, and attach a wig to the head.



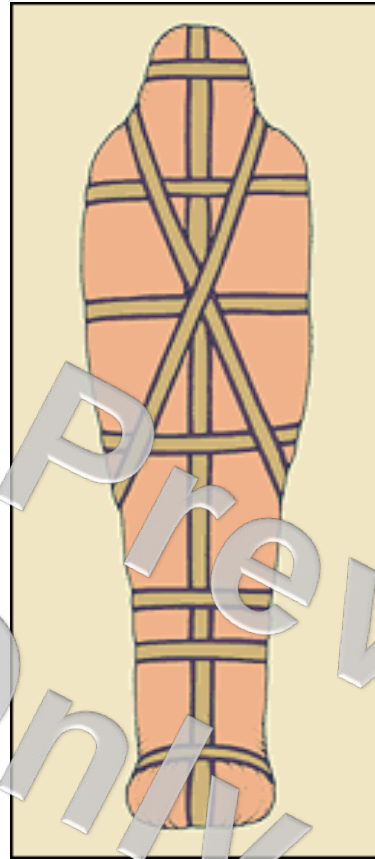
Apply oil from myrrh and crushed leaves to the body. This will be the body's perfume. Then add melted resin to the body to help preserve it.



Once the resin has dried, wrap the body in linen, but remember to add amulets every so often. Once wrapped in linen, carefully place the golden mask over the mummy.



Finally, place the mummified body into the inner casket. Remember to add his book of the dead.



Seal the casket. The body is ready for its journey to the underworld.
