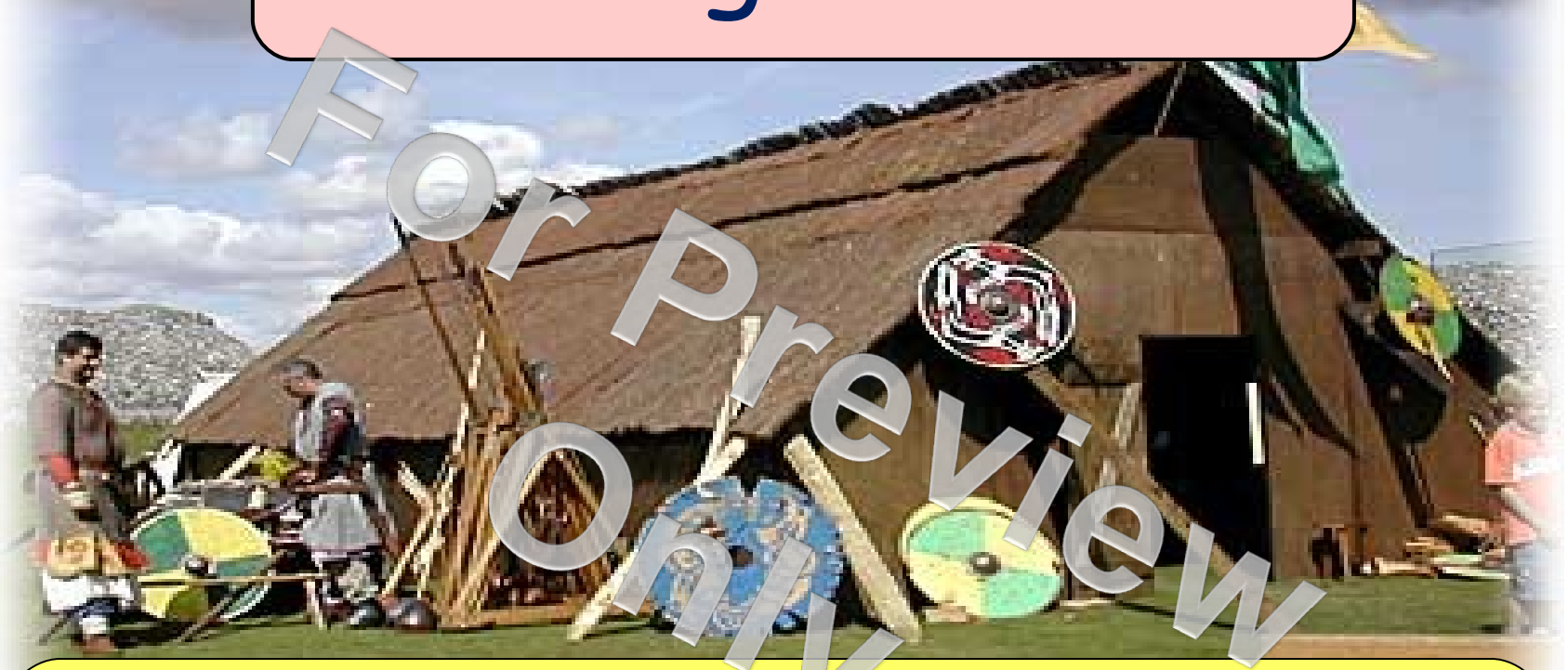




Viking Homes

In the middle of the room was an open fire set in a long hearth. This gave the Vikings heat and light.
