1852. All main railway routes completed.



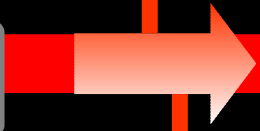


1872. First FA Cup final.

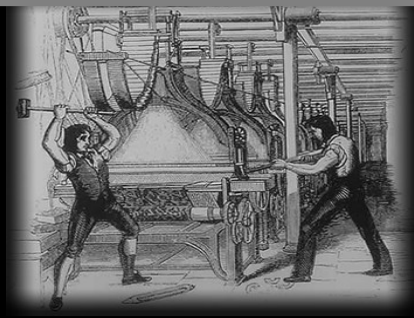
