Year 6



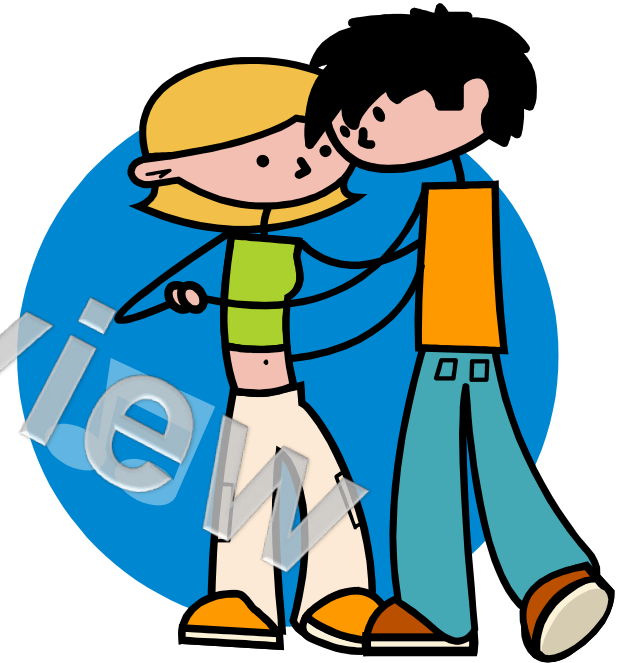
